- Are properly checked and approved by all relevant bodies, and references are properly tracked and validated.
- Where appropriate are trained to the appropriate level and qualified:
 - Managers: FA Level 1 Standard, Child Safeguarding AND Emergency First Aid
 - o Coaches: Child Safeguarding AND Emergency First Aid.
- Agree and commit to abiding by all the clubs rules, codes of conduct, to attending all relevant meetings and attend any re-training or refresher training deemed appropriate by the club.
